# AGS Treasurer's Report To Membership Meeting 10-28-23 Georgia Gourd Show, Griffin, GA

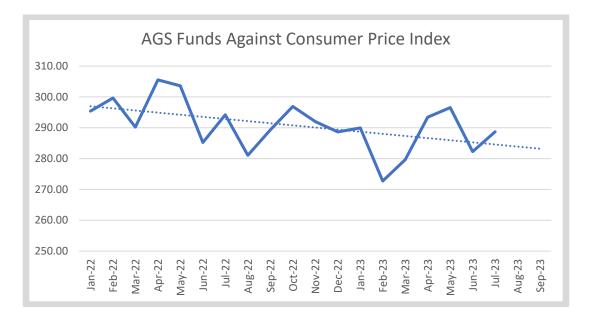
